



### **Reformation Review Game Directions:**

The Reformation review game has two game boards with five categories per board and a bonus question.

The point value on each board links to a corresponding clue. The home icon on the bottom of each slide returns to the game board containing that category. This functionality is in place during the slide show.

A text box advances from round one to round two, and round two to the bonus question.

The clue slides are arranged in the order of the category boards. Answers are included in the notes section of each slide. An answer key is also provided below. Answers are phrased in the form of a question.

The point value on the board does not disappear when the question is read. The use of clues needs to be manually tracked by crossing out the point value as each clue is used.

If scoring is desired, points will need to be tracked manually.

- *German Words and Phrases* asks for the English translation.
- *Martin Luther* is about the life of Martin Luther.
- *Katie Luther* is about the life of Katie Luther.

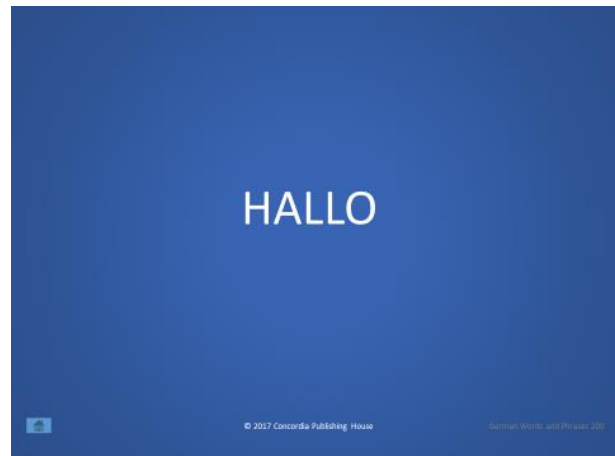

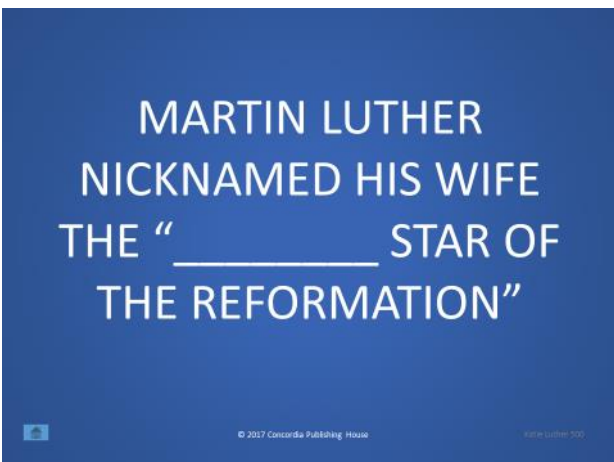

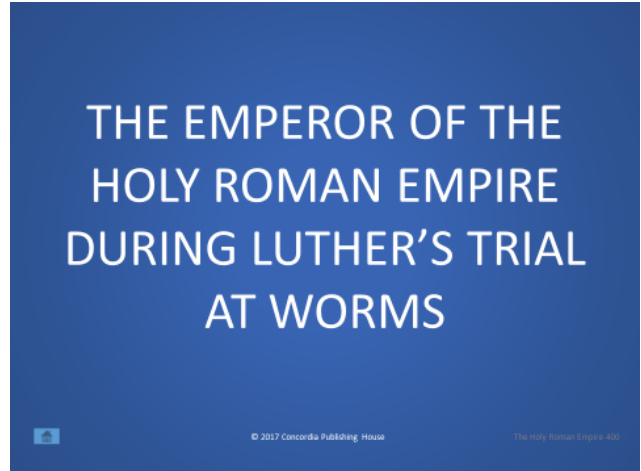
